Poultry Judging Schedule

Classes 1401-1446 and classes 1497-1516 – Thursday, August 4 beginning at 9 a.m.

Classes 1447-1496 – Friday, August 5 beginning at 9 a.m.

Rules:

- A. All birds must be owned and in exhibitor's care by June 1, 2016.
(July 1 for classes 1443, 1444)
- B. Each exhibitor is limited to one entry in each class and is limited to sixteen (16) total chicken entries and fourteen (14) waterfowl/misc. poultry entries in their display. These entries do not include egg entries, showmanship, or rooster crowing/Honk Quack contest entries.
- C. All exhibitors must be present during judging unless otherwise approved by superintendents.
Exhibitors must wear appropriate attire when exhibiting. A shirt with a collar, tucked in at the waist will constitute appropriate attire. Closed-toed shoes must also be worn by exhibitors during exhibition. Failure to conform to this rule will result in dismissal from the show ring at the discretion of the superintendents.
- D. Birds shown in individual classes (including bantams) cannot be shown in the pen classes.
 1. Cockerel – A male hatched after December 1, 2015.
 2. Pullet – A female hatched after December 1, 2015.
 3. Pen – Consists of one male and two females hatched after December 1, 2015.
 4. Egg Production – Each exhibitor in egg production classes **must also exhibit** a pen of **three mature hens** selected from his or her project flock. Pen of Old Hens' breed must match egg production breed. Exhibitors may show a different breed in egg production than in chick brooding classes.
 5. Young Male – A male hatched after December 1, 2015.
 6. Young Female – A female hatched after December 1, 2015.
 7. Old Male – A male hatched prior to December 1, 2015.
 8. Old Female – A female hatched prior to December 1, 2015.
- E. Bedding, feed and containers must be furnished by the exhibitor. Each exhibitor is responsible for keeping their exhibit area clean. This includes the pens and the area around their pens. This will be at the discretion of the superintendents.
- F. All poultry must have a numbered leg band. (Available from superintendents.)
- G. All broilers and fryers must be weighed when checking in.
- H. Due to limited space, birds entering the Rooster crowing/Honk Quack contests must be selected from one of the birds that is already being exhibited. No additional birds will be allowed.
