General Rules

- \$4 per class for pre-entry. Day of entry per class is \$8. (McLean County 4-H Exhibitors will receive 50% of the registration fee back if registered in advance online by July 26 at 2 p.m.)
- Must have health papers available
- Exhibitors must be 21 years of age or younger
- Birds will be exhibited by breeds
- All birds must be owned by the exhibitor by June 1, 2024
- All entries must have pullorum testing and NPIP Flock Paperwork available
- Each exhibitor must comply with the Illinois Exhibition Health Requirements; Animal Care, Drug, Testing and Welfare Policies
- Poultry shown must be the property of the exhibitor and must be identified with numbered leg bands (available from the directors). The exhibitor will write the leg band on the cage card the bird is in and must match the entry form.
- Bedding, feed, and containers must be furnished by the exhibitor.
- Any bird exhibiting signs of poor health and condition, or a pronounced defect or abnormality will be ineligible to show and receive premiums at the discretion of the Superintendent.
- The Premier Livestock Show Committee reserves the right to make any final decisions on the rules and settle any disputes.
