- \$30 pre-entry fee per head. \$40 day of entry fee per head. (McLean County 4-H Exhibitors will receive 50% of the registration fee back if registered in advance online by July 26 at 2 p.m.)
- Must have health papers available
- Exhibitors must be 21 years of age & younger
- Exhibitors will declare their own market animal weights
- This will be an IMGP sanctioned points show
- Registration papers for Percentage and Fullblood goats must be available
- W-9 paperwork may need to be completed

Identification

1. Individual identification of each animal shall be by an ear tattoo or official metal or plastic tag.
2. A microchip ID is acceptable if the owner provides the reader.
3. Tattoos may be used when a registration certificate, listing the tattoo number, accompanies the animal.
4. When using ear tags, the tag must indicate the premises ID and state of origin. The tag number must be assigned by a state or APHIS representative and recorded in the Scrapie Record Database.
5. Ears should be used for tattooing when possible. If there is no space in the ear, the flank or tail fold may be used. 1. Goats originating from a herd that has previously been classified as either an infected or source herd can be exhibited in Illinois upon the completion of an approved herd plan.
6. For any animal born after 1/1/2002, the CVI must include the flock of birth and the flock of origin, if different.
7. Goats originating from a herd that has previously been classified as either an infected or source herd can be exhibited in Illinois upon the completion of an approved herd plan.
8. Tuberculosis- Goats from areas or states that are not Accredited Bovine Tuberculosis Free, must be accompanied by a CVI indicating that the goats originated from a herd where a complete negative herd test has been conducted within the past twelve (12) months and the individual animals are negative to a tuberculin test conducted within thirty (30) days prior to entry. For any animal born after 1/1/2002, the CVI must include the flock of birth and the flock of origin, if different.

Goat Show Rules

1. All goats will be checked in at the pens and verified to be in the correct breed classes at that time. Health papers at time of check in.
2. Animals must have been on exhibitor's property by June 1 of the current year.
3. No bucks, regardless of age, will be allowed on the grounds.
4. Wethers should show no evidence of testicular matter. Wethers will be inspected during check in and any wethers showing evidence of testicular matter will be sent home.
5. Wether class splits will be determined by weight.
6. Age of goats is determined by date of show.
7. Health regulations as outlined in health rules will be strictly enforced.
8. All exhibitors are required to examine their goats, prior to arrival at stands for contagious ailments especially sore mouth, ringworm, and active abscesses. Certificates of Veterinary Inspection are required.
9. This will be an IMGP sanctioned points show and will follow their rules.
10. The show committee reserves the right to make any final decisions on the rules and settle any disputes.
